Workshops: Workshop presenters are asked to indicate the length of time they will require to present their workshop, anywhere from one hour to four hours. Those abstracts not selected for workshops may be offered a poster presentation or display space.

New inventors: The conference committee are looking for innovations and improvements in equipment and assistive devices released to the Australian market since the last conference. Papers will be allocated a total of 5 minutes presentation time, followed by 5 minutes of panel questions. Submissions with the top initiatives will be invited to present at the conference.
